So what is personlising learning? Another Government initiative or the very core of the moral puprose of why we are all in education?

This two day conference will seek to explore themes around personalising learning. Led by world class educational leaders the conference will provide new ways of thinking and will provide you with the time to reflect on where you and your school are right now on the journey towards personalised learning.

Day 1 will be led by Professor David Hargreaves and will focus on the development of a coherent model of personalising learning and the creation of a vision for education fit for the beginning of the 21st Century.

Day 2 will see key note addresses by Ewan McIntosh of New Technologies for Learning and Sean McDougall, Managing Director of Stakeholder Design. Ewan will focus on how new technologies can be used to support and to liberate learning so that it is truly personalised. Sean will focus on whether or not schools are fit for purpose and what can be done to redesign schooling so that it supports a more personalised approach. Also on Day 2 will be practical workshops led by school practitioners on their journey towards more creative and personalised approaches to learning, and educational software providers.



Oulton Hall Hotel is situated by the parish church in the village of Oulton to the south east of Leeds City centre (7 miles).

From the M62: Leave the M62 at junction 30 following signs for Rothwell. You will see a sign for Oulton.  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles. Follow this road to the first roundabout and take the first exit: at the second roundabout take the first exit again. The entrance to Oulton Hall is on your left.

From the M1: Take junction 42 for the M62, following signs for Hull. Once on the M62 take junction 30 following directions as above or alternatively take junction 44 signposted Castleford / Pontefract / Rothwell A639 down to the roundabout. Then take right exit at roundabout and hotel is on the left.

From the A1: From the North follow the A1/M1 link road signposted for Leeds/London/Manchester and take junction 44. Turn left at top of slip road and follow the A639 down to roundabout. Then turn right at roundabout and Hotel is left.
